European Journal of Therapeutics aims to contribute to the international literature by publishing original research, review articles, case reports, letters to the Editor, editorials (only Editors use), special editorial (only Editors use), reply by authors, in memory of (invited by EIC only) and book review (invited by EIC only) in the fields of medical sciences.

The journal's target audience comprises researchers, physicians, and healthcare professionals actively engaged in or deeply interested in all disciplines across the broad spectrum of medical sciences. For details, please refer to the [Aim and Scope](#) page.

The European Journal of Therapeutics implements an "Early View" publication model. Manuscripts that have completed the peer review process, received editorial acceptance, and undergone final typesetting are published online with a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) before being assigned to a specific volume and issue. For details, please refer to the [Early View Publication Policy](#) page.

The European Journal of Therapeutics maintains a policy of no financial barriers for authors or readers. As the European Journal of Therapeutics, our fundamental criteria for every manuscript considered for publication are unwavering originality, superior scientific quality, and significant citation potential. It is imperative that submissions presented for evaluation have not been previously published or presented in any electronic or printed medium. Should a manuscript have been submitted to another journal for assessment and

subsequently rejected for publication, it is obligatory to inform our journal; in such instances, the provision of prior reviewer reports will substantially accelerate our evaluation process.

Should the research have been previously presented at a conference or meeting, full details must be disclosed at the point of submission. The title page of the manuscript is required to include the name of the meeting, the date it was convened, and its geographical location (City, Country). Every manuscript submitted to the European Journal of Therapeutics undergoes a meticulous double-anonymized peer-review process, designed to ensure an unbiased assessment. Within this framework, each submission is rigorously examined by at least two external and independent peer reviewers, all of whom are experts in their respective fields. Furthermore, in cases where manuscripts are submitted by our Editors or members of the Editorial Board, our Editorial Board will specifically engage an external and independent Editor to oversee and manage the evaluation procedures. The Editor in Chief is the final authority in the decision-making process for all submissions.

An approval of research protocols by the Ethics Committee following international agreements (World Medical Association Declaration of Helsinki "Ethical Principles for Medical Research Involving Human Subjects," amended in October 2024, [www.wma.net](http://www.wma.net)) is required for experimental, clinical, and drug studies and some case reports. Ethics Committee approval information, including the name of the approving institution, approval date, and approval number, must be declared on the title page and under the Materials and Methods section of the manuscript. Authors should provide the ethics committee reports.

As the European Journal of Therapeutics, we mandate that manuscripts presenting experimental studies with human participants include a definitive statement verifying that comprehensive, written informed consent was secured from all individuals, after a thorough explanation of all procedures involved. Correspondingly, for research conducted on animal subjects, a precise delineation of the measures implemented to preclude pain and mitigate suffering is an essential requirement.

All submissions are screened by similarity detection software (iThenticate by CrossCheck).

The similarity rate limit determined for our journal is 24%. For details, please refer to the Plagiarism page.

In any instance where research misconduct is alleged or suspected – including, but not limited to, plagiarism, manipulative citation practices, or the fabrication/falsification of data – our Editorial Board will meticulously adhere to and implement the comprehensive guidelines established by the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE). Each individual listed as an author should fulfill the authorship criteria recommended by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE - [www.icmje.org](http://www.icmje.org)). Authorship must be based on four key criteria: substantial contributions to the conception or design of the work, or the acquisition, analysis, or interpretation of data; drafting the work



or revising it critically for important intellectual content; final approval of the version to be published; and agreement to be accountable for all aspects of the work, ensuring that questions related to its accuracy or integrity are appropriately investigated and resolved. An author must be able to identify which co-authors are responsible for specific parts of the work and should have confidence in the integrity of their co-authors' contributions. All those designated as authors should meet all four criteria for authorship, and all who meet the four criteria should be identified as authors. ## WRITING RULES

The guidelines established for the preparation of articles submitted to the European Journal of Therapeutics have been prepared following the ICMJE Guidelines for Preparing Articles for Submission to Medical Journals.

Manuscripts can only be submitted through the journal's online submission and evaluation system, available at <https://eurjther.com/>. Manuscripts submitted via any other medium will not be evaluated.

As the European Journal of Therapeutics, we ensure that every manuscript submitted undergoes an initial, rigorous technical evaluation. Our dedicated Editorial Office staff meticulously verifies that each submission fully aligns with the journal's comprehensive guidelines. Any manuscript found not to comply with these directives will be promptly returned to the submitting author, accompanied by specific requests for technical rectification. Please be advised that the Editor reserves the absolute right to decline submissions that fail to meet these essential requirements.

Authors are expected to address any identified technical deficiencies within three business days. For necessary corrections requiring more extensive work, authors are granted a maximum of 15 days. Manuscripts that fail to meet these technical requirements or are deemed incomplete may be rejected at this stage.

The corresponding author is responsible for ensuring the accurate declaration of all authors' information and for providing all required submission details, including the complete title page and necessary forms. The corresponding author is expected to be readily available to address any requested corrections or missing information.

For all experimental, clinical, and drug studies, authors must provide an ethics committee approval report following international agreements.

#### **Title Page**

A separate title page should be submitted with all submissions, and this page should include:

- The full title of the manuscript is no more than 15 words (avoid using abbreviations).
- Name, address, telephone (including the mobile phone number), and e-mail address of the corresponding author,
- Name(s), affiliations, highest academic degree(s) and contact information of the author(s),
- Add the 16-digit ORCID of the author (s)
- Grant information and detailed information on the other sources of support,
- Conflict of Interest Statement: Potential conflicts of interest must be declared.
- In studies involving human participants, a declaration of informed consent must be made.
- A data-sharing declaration must be made, specifying which data can be shared and when it will be available. A link to the repositories where the study sets to be shared will be accessible must be provided.
- The name of the ethics committee and the date of approval must be stated in the manuscript.
- Authors must be identified according to their contributions.

Individuals who contributed to the preparation of the article but do not meet the authorship criteria should be acknowledged in the acknowledgements section.

#### **Main Text**

Place the title, abstract, and keywords on the first page of the main text.

Organize the manuscript into four main headings: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, and Discussion.

Limitations, drawbacks, and shortcomings of original articles should be mentioned in the Discussion section before the conclusion paragraph. Then place the references and figure legends in the main text, respectively.

All references, tables, and figures should be referred to within the main text, and they should be numbered consecutively in the order they are referred to within the main text.

Define abbreviations at first mention in the text and each table and figure.

If a brand name is cited, supply the manufacturer’s name and address (city and state/country).

DO NOT EMBED IMAGES or TABLES in the mail text.

#### **Main Points**

The content of the “Main Points” title should consist of an average of four items (as a separate file in Word format).

#### **Text Formatting**

Manuscripts should be submitted in Word.

Use a normal, plain font (e.g., 12-point Times Roman, 1.5 line spacing, and justified) for text.

Do not use field functions.

Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.

Do not indent at the beginning of a line.

Save the file in docx format (Word 2013 or higher).

#### **Tables**

All tables are to be numbered using Arabic numerals.

Tables should always be cited in text in consecutive numerical order.

Each table must be uploaded as separate files (e.g., table 1, table 2, and table 3).

#### **Abbreviations and Symbols**

Abbreviations should be avoided in the title. Clarity and consistency must be maintained within the main text. When first used, abbreviations

should be presented with their full form in parentheses, and thereafter, only the abbreviation should be used. In lengthy texts, an acronym may be reintroduced with its full form in parentheses at its first use within each new section.

#### **Units of Measurement**

Standard units and symbols should adhere to the rules of the International System of Units (SI). Please provide converted values in SI units in parentheses. Write unit symbols correctly (e.g., for millimeter “mm” in lowercase, for kilogram “kg” in lowercase). Do not put periods after symbols (e.g., “kg.” not “kg”). Do not use plurals (e.g., “5 kgs” not “5 kg”).

#### **Supplementary Materials**

Supplementary materials, which complement the main text of the article, including datasets and additional documents (e.g., appendices, supplementary figures, tables), should be uploaded as separate files and presented as a distinct section after the reference list. Each supplementary material must include brief descriptions to explain its relevance to the article. Page numbering is not required for supplementary materials.

#### **Use of Products**

When referencing any specific drug, product, hardware, or software program within the manuscript, always include the product’s full name, the manufacturer, and their city and country in parentheses immediately after the first mention of the item.

#### **Author-Suggested Reviewers**

Authors are required to propose at least five reviewers when submitting their manuscripts.

It should be noted that there should be no conflict of interest between these proposed reviewers and the authors, and that these recommendations should comply with international ethical standards.

Recommended reviewers should have competence in the subject of the article.

The proposed reviewers must not have collaborated with the authors of the article in the last three years and must not be working in the same institution.

#### **Revisions**

When submitting a revised version of a paper, the author must submit a detailed “Response to the reviewers” that states point by point how each issue raised by the reviewers has been covered and where it can be found (each reviewer’s comment, followed by the author’s reply and line numbers where the changes have been made) as well as an annotated copy of the main document.

Revisions should be marked on the main text file with a yellow background. The deadline for submitting revised manuscripts is set at seven calendar days following the dispatch of the decision letter. If the revised version of the manuscript is not submitted within the allocated time, the revision option may be canceled.

Accepted manuscripts are copy-edited for grammar, punctuation, and format. Once the publication process of a manuscript is completed, it is published online on the journal’s webpage as an ahead-of-print publication before it is included in its scheduled issue. A PDF proof of the accepted manuscript is sent to the corresponding author, and their

## Withdrawn

Articles accepted for publication and published in early view may be withdrawn in the following cases:

The Editor will decide to remove the retracted article from publication in conjunction with the Editorial Board. The Editors reserve the right to publish the article, depending on the degree of error in its content.

## Retraction
